

What to do in an emergency:

Contact the emergency number. Try to remain calm. Identify the emergency. Give your name and contact details. State the nature of the incident and the number of people involved. Give the physical address and nearest corner or landmark. Remain on the line for as long as possible to answer the operator's questions.
